The pilot stated that during landing prior to touch-down the right-hand wing lifted sharply and he was unable to initiate corrective action resulting in a loss of directional control of the aircraft.

The aircraft veered left, off the runway and collided with some bushes, damaging the left undercarriage and left wing.

Probable Cause

The pilot lost directional control of the aircraft during landing.
