Svnopsis					

No on-site investigation was carried out.

On 16 September 2001, at approximately 1100Z, the pilot and one passenger took-off from FAGC for a private local flight. Towards the quarry, 3 NM south of FAGC and at 600'AGL, the pilot decided to give the passenger a demonstration of a "quick-stop" followed by an "auto-rotation".

The pilot allowed the rotor RPM to decay to the point where the "Low rotor RPM-horn" was activated. In an attempt to correct the situation a hard landing followed, during which the helicopter sustained substantial damage.

The pilot was the holder of a valid license and a valid medical certificate.

According to available documentation, the helicopter was serviceable prior to the accident.

Probable Cause

The pilot allowed the rotor RPM to decay to the point where the "Low rotor RPM-horn" was activated.

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
