She initiated recovery action by applying aileron instead of rudder causing a diverging roll to the left as the wing stalled. The left wing collided with the ground and the aircraft pivoted through 180° crashing into the ground.

The aircraft was extensively damaged but both occupants were unhurt.

The aircraft had a valid Authority to Fly and was only operated for 9 hours since the Annual inspection.

Probable Cause

Due to a sudden gust of wind and incorrect control input the pilot lost control of the aircraft during landing.
